



THE IDEA

A marketplace for community projects for Philadelphia

CODE *for* AMERICA

Expected Outcome: An open source web application enhancing citizen engagement and government transparency.

Will strive to: improve communication, help organize individuals & others around problems and geography, and help solicit and organize input from a range of stakeholders.

- Code for America is a new non-profit modeled after Teach for America that applies the principles of Web 2.0 to civic problems.
- Code for America competitively selects several cities to work with on a project that increases the city's transparency, participation, and efficiency.
- Philadelphia applied for and was selected as one of four winning cities along with Boston, Washington, and Seattle.
- Philadelphia will be hosting seven program fellows for a month starting at the end of January 2011 and the program will last through 2011.






A SOLUTION

Issues are channeled to appropriate representative for resolution via meeting space platform




Value Proposition to the City

- Philadelphia received approximately \$1.3 million in services for \$225k in cost
- Positive national exposure for winning competitive proposal process
- Collaborative opportunities with other partner cities
- Participation in experimental vanguard using the Internet to advance government-as-platform sparked “civic fusion”
- Significant enhancement to Philadelphia’s citizen engagement and outreach capacity
 - CfA fellows ambassadorial role
 - The magic was in us all along
